	Lines 3-5	There are two types of re-entry permit: a single re-entry permit (fee: 3,000 yen) that can be used once, and a multiple re-entry permit (fee: 6,000 yen) that can be used any number of times during the period of validity.	When the Re-entry Permit application is approved, the required fee is ¥4,000 for a single re-entry or ¥7,000 for multiple re-entries. (Payment must be made with revenue stamps.) For online applications, the fee is ¥3,500 for a single re-entry or ¥6,500 for multiple re-entries. (Payment must also be made with revenue stamps.)
