

Notice for refugees residing in Japan:

When you were asked to leave your job by your employer...!

1. Make sure about the followings before you quit!
 - Aren't you asked to leave your job against your will?
 - For dispatched workers, isn't your dismissal during the contract period and without a fair reason?

If you are not comfortable with the reason for dismissal, please feel free to consult with RHQ or your nearest Labor Standards Inspection Office (Roudou Kijun Kantokusho) before you give a formal response to your employer.

2. RHQ provides consultation on the following matters after your requirement.
 - Job search and related activities
 - e.g. job search, information provision regarding vocational trainings for reemployment etc.
 - Paperwork for changes with public insurance registration etc.
 - e.g. health insurance, welfare pension insurance, employment insurance etc.
 - Issues with daily living
 - e.g. housing, education etc.

Contact information varies depending on your matter of concern (e.g. job search, administrative procedure etc.) following your retirement. Please contact RHQ Job Counselors if you have any questions.
