Application for Year 2020 Courses

Refugee Assistance Headquarters (RHQ) is now accepting applications for the on-line Settlement Support Program including Japanese Language Education for Convention Refugees starting in October 2020.

Settlement Support Program

Qualified Applicants:

Individuals who are recognized as refugees by the Minister of Justice in Japan and their family members*

(*Family members: Husbands, wives, parents and unmarried children of Convention Refugees in Japan, who have been granted the status of residence)

Venue: At each participant's home (On-line learning with PC or other devices at home)

Contents: Japanese Language Education (approx..572 units), Guidance for Japanese Life (approx..120 units), and Employment Support Service.

Courses: October 2020~ March 2021 (Mon.-Fri., 9:30~15:50)

Each person can attend the course only once.

Remarks: For preventing COVID19 infection, the Settlement Support Program is provided by group learning only via on-line. Those who have PC and Internet environment will be accepted first.

If you do not have internet or PC at home, please contact RHQ.

Note: It is possible that application might be declined. No baby-sitting service available during the on-line course.

2. 2020.6~2020.8 Interview on-line.
3. 2020.9 Result of your application arrives.
4. 2020.10 Course starts.
