Assistance for Applicants for Recognition of Persons Subject to Complementary Protection

The Refugee Assistance Headquarters (RHQ) provides assistance to complementary protection applicants who are suffering from economic hardship.

1. Eligible Persons

Persons who are eligible to receive assistance are applicants for Recognition of Persons Subject to Complementary Protection (including persons who filed on appeal) who are considered to be in need of protection, such as persons who live in a high degree of poverty in Japan; lacking in clothing, food, accommodation; etc.

- (NOTE 1) Persons who are eligible to apply for assistance are limited to those who fulfill one of the conditions below;
- (1) Persons who are on the first application for recognition of persons subject to complementary protection to the Ministry of Justice;
- (2) Persons who make an objection against the result of the first application to the Ministry of Justice;
- (3) Persons who file a case to a law court of a first instance for a rejection of the first application for persons subject to complementary protection if s/he is not on the first application for persons subject to complementary protection to the Ministry of Justice.
- (NOTE 2) Persons may not be considered to be in need of assistance if they have assets or income; if they are able to work; if they have relatives on whom they should and can depend; if they are receiving public assistance, etc.; or if it has been determined that the implementation of assistance for them is inappropriate.
